Swimmers age 15 to 17 years of age must have a completed authorization/waiver

Children in the pool must be supervised by an adult
No running or rough housing
Bikes, scooters, roller blades not permitted
No glass containers

No diving or jumping off the side of the pool or ledge FAMILY FRIENDLY swim attire

No abusive language or loud radios

Liberty HOA is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to personal effects

Liberty HOA assumes no responsibility for any personal injury resulting from using the pool

No rafts or floatation devices

Alcohol is NOT permitted at the pool area

#1 compliance issue in Liberty : Trash Cans MUST be Stored Out of View

Inspect your fence for needed repairs. Check for broken boards & leaning panels

Holiday Decor can be placed 30 days prior to the holiday and **MUST** be removed no later than 30 days after the holiday

Boats, trailers, trucks and RV's are **NOT** permitted in Liberty



Dogs **MUST** be on a lease when being walked in common areas & please remember to utilize pet waste stations throughout the community

Community Etiquette: Please be mindful of your neighbors. Whether it is the volume of your music, porch tv's or parking, let's be mindful

Landscaping: Tree Rings and Landscape Borders are permitted. Must be brick, stone or rock. Metal or plastic borders are prohibited. The plans must be submitted to the ACC Committee

The homeowner is responsible to maintain their yard in a sanitary and attractive manner. Adequate watering, replacement of dead vegetation, mow lawns at regular intervals and remove weeds

Basketball Goals:

They can be kept in the front of the house as long as they are far enough back from the street to where if it falls, it cannot reach the sidewalk.

The city prefers them as close to the garage as possible.

They can not be placed in the right of way at all, especially in the street or sidewalk.

If it is far enough away from the sidewalk, then it can not create any issues such as falling on someone walking by.

This also keeps children out of the street.









"For Rent" or "For Lease" signs are prohibited in Liberty.

An owner may lease its residence for a minimum of 6 months

The dwelling must be leased in its entirety

Any lease requires a written contact or lease be provided to the HOA prior to commencement

Residences shall be used exclusively for single family purposes





Golf carts in the City limits must be registered with the Melissa Police Department.

Please be sure to familiarize yourself with the Equipment must meet Texas and Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards

Register your golf cart June 10th from 9:30am to 2:00pm at Liberty Stars & Stripes Parking Lot

The golf cart must have the following equipment which are in good working and operational order:

Parking brake Rearview mirror(s), capable of a clear, unobstructed view of at least 200 feet to the rear Side, reflectors (two front, amber in color and two rear red in color) Slow-moving vehicle emblem

Two headlamps

Two tail lamps

The maximum speed limit on the public street is 35 miles per hour or less
